NCL's organized Shore Excursion program offers you the opportunity to sample the colorful culture and see the most dramatic scenery in each port of call. Pre-arranged sightseeing saves valuable time in port and helps ensure you receive the best services available.

## WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

### **Why should I book an organized Shore Excursion?**

There are a number of advantages to booking a Shore Excursion organized by Norwegian Cruise Line, including:

#### **Satisfaction**

We carefully monitor Shore Excursion programs to ensure we are offering the best tours available and meeting the diverse needs and interests of our guests. We use only reputable and licensed independent tour operators.

#### **Convenience**

Our organized tours maximize your time ashore and eliminate the need for time-consuming, last-minute arrangements in port.

#### **Service**

We have a professional and knowledgeable Shore Excursion staff onboard, available to help you expertly plan your time ashore.

#### **Safety**

We have developed Shore Excursion programs with primary consideration for your safety and security.

#### **Value**

We review our tours continuously to ensure they are of the highest quality and that prices remain competitive.

### **How does the Shore Excursion program work?**

Shore Excursions may be reserved in advance. A request form is provided with this document so that you may finalize your plans well in advance of your cruise. This form must be received by NCL no later than two weeks prior to your sailing date. Do not send payment! Orders will be processed and billed to your onboard account. Shore Excursions are also available for purchase on board. Early in the cruise, the Shore Excursion Manager will present the most up-to-date information on ports and tours. Pick up a Shore Excursion order form at the Shore Excursion Desk. Return the completed form to the Shore Excursion Desk or Drop Box as soon as possible since all requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Purchases will be billed to your onboard account. Tickets will be delivered to your stateroom.

### **Are there any restrictions?**

An adult must accompany participants under the age of 18 on all tours. There is no charge for children under the age of two who do not occupy a separate seat. Some tours have additional restrictions implemented for your safety. These may include age, weight, height and/or medical history related restrictions. Please refer to the individual tour description for any restrictions or consult with the Shore Excursion Desk on board.

### **Should I tip the guide/driver?**

Tip is strictly optional; however, most tour guides and drivers expect and appreciate a modest gratuity. A commonly accepted guideline is \$1 per person for a half-day tour and \$2 per person for a full-day tour. If food and/or beverages are not included as a part of your tour, an additional gratuity for these services is appropriate.

### **What type of clothing should I wear?**

We suggest you wear comfortable walking shoes or sneakers and dress in warm, layered clothing. Due to unpredictable weather, it is also advisable to bring along a sweater, windbreaker and/or rain gear, and bring sun protection for tours involving outdoor activities. All tours operate rain or shine! Do not forget your camera and plenty of film!

## **What tours are recommended for families?**

All tours are suitable for families; however, we do not recommend flight seeing tours for children four years of age and younger. For a more affordable family experience, many tours offer lower prices for children. Some tours have additional age restrictions implemented for your safety. Please refer to the individual tour description for any additional restrictions or consult with the Shore Excursion Desk on board.

## **Will we miss meals?**

With Freestyle Cruising, you don't have to worry about missing a meal. Dining rooms offer open seating, and are open from 5:30 pm-midnight every evening.

## **What if we miss the ship?**

NCL does not leave port until all organized tours have returned to the ship. If you leave an organized tour however, or make tour arrangements on your own, please keep the time in mind and return to the ship at least 30 minutes before sailing.

## **What if I have made my own flight arrangements - will I be able to purchase airport transfers?**

Prior to your cruise, transfers may be purchased through NCL by calling reservations at 1.800.327.7030, or on board during your cruise at the Shore Excursion Desk.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### **Responsibility**

NCL, as a convenience to its guests, may sell tickets for Shore Excursions or arrange other services which are operated by independent contractors not affiliated with NCL. NCL cannot be responsible for the acts or omissions of these independent contractors. NCL's responsibility to guests on board Norwegian Cruise Line vessels is governed by provisions in the Passenger Ticket Contract and does not extend beyond the vessel.

### **Cancellation or Modification**

Cruise schedules are subject to change at the discretion of the Captain, and may occasionally be affected by variations in arrival or departure times, inclement weather, and mechanical or equipment difficulties. NCL reserves the right to change Shore Excursion prices and itineraries without notice. Excursions are subject to cancellation or modification depending on the number of guests participating. NCL reserves the right to cancel a Shore Excursion for any reason, including inclement weather, and shall not be liable for any loss to participants. Participants holding tickets for canceled Shore Excursions will receive a full refund. Should it be necessary to abandon a Shore Excursion due to difficulties en route, NCL will arrange the best possible refund for participants according to the circumstances.

### **Refunds and Cancellation Fees**

All tours cancelled within 24 hours prior to arrival in the port where the tour is scheduled to operate are non-refundable. Certain tours, such as overland tours, flightseeing tours, customized tours and tours with theater performances or special events may be subject to different cancellation fees. Check with the Shore Excursion Desk for details. You can cancel a tour by returning the tour ticket to the Shore Excursion Desk and advising the staff of the cancellation. Refunds will be credited to the guest's onboard account.

### **Prices**

Prices include meals and refreshments as indicated in the tour description (including gratuities for these services), plus guide and entrance fees, unless otherwise noted. Children (except those who do not occupy a separate seat) are charged full price, unless otherwise noted. All prices are in U.S. dollars.

### **Tour Descriptions, Durations and Departure Times**

The tour descriptions are as current and accurate as possible considering that the brochure is published several months prior to your cruise. Please note that occasionally changes in the description do occur. Any significant changes will be noted on the NCL website. Some tours will operate in an order that is different from that presented in the brochure. This helps to alleviate crowding at local venues. The information in the brochure is designed to help you select the excursions most suited to your interests. The individual tour descriptions include approximate durations and can be found under each tour name. Please note that departure times are subject to change. Please check the NCL website ([www.ncl.com/shorex](http://www.ncl.com/shorex)) for the most current descriptions.

### **Insurance**

The duties and liabilities of a particular tour operator and the scope and extent of the operator's insurance coverage may vary widely, depending upon the country's laws and customs. ## **Personal Possessions**

Personal articles including cameras, handbags, umbrellas, etc. are the guest's responsibility. NCL does not assume responsibility or liability for any item, or for personal effects, lost or damaged during any Shore Excursion or activity undertaken on behalf of the guest.

## **Tour Operators**

Tour operators have the right to require any individual to withdraw from a tour at any time if they deem the individual's conduct detrimental to or incompatible with the interests, comfort, well-being or harmony of the group as a whole. Tour operators reserve the right to alter or adjust itineraries to meet local conditions for participant safety and convenience. Neither NCL nor local tour operators can extend financial reimbursement to compensate for a participant's disappointment in the event circumstances beyond the reasonable control of NCL or the tour operator make it impossible to provide services as intended.

## **Transportation**

The best available local transportation is utilized in every port of call. However, guests should recognize that quality standards vary considerably throughout the world. Air-conditioned motor coaches are not always available. Cars, vans or taxis are often used in ports where coach transport is limited or not available.

## **Physically Challenged Guests**

While NCL strives to make its Shore Excursion program available to all its guests, inherent tour venue limitations and/or tour operator limitations exist that are beyond NCL's control that limit the ability of guests with special needs to participate in certain Shore Excursions. We urge such guests to advise the Shore Excursion department of special needs when pre-booking tours and to further meet with the Shore Excursion Manager on board to discuss their special needs as they relate with the unique characteristics of each Shore Excursion. We typically recommend independent transportation for the comfort and convenience of guests with special needs.

## **TOUR INDICATORS/SYMBOLS**

- Level 1: Tours with this designation involve walking over relatively level terrain. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- Level 2: Tours with this designation can involve a considerable amount of physical activity such as climbing stairs or steep terrain. They are not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended. This designation can also indicate the need for swimming in a light current, or bicycle riding.
- Level 3: Tours with this designation involve physical exertion for extended periods of time. The terrain may be uneven or steep. They are recommended only for the physically fit and adventurous traveler.
- Physically Limited: Accommodates guests with limited mobility or in wheelchairs, provided there is a companion to assist them in and out of motorcoaches or other transportation or with the navigation of venues with uneven terrain and/or steps insofar as some or all of the destinations on this tour do not provide special access and/or equipment. Wheelchairs must be collapsible. Please notify the onboard Shore Excursion staff of any special needs or concerns 48 hours prior to the requested tour departure.
- Meal: This tour includes a meal.
- C-Card: All participants must be certified Scuba divers and must have logged a Scuba dive or completed a refresher course within the past 12 months. You must present a nationally recognized certification card and complete a short medical history and release form at the time of booking. If you are thinking of participating in the Scuba program and have a known medical condition, please get a clearance letter from your physician stating that you have no restrictions to dive. This should be done prior to taking your cruise and the original letter should be brought along with you. Junior Open Water divers between the ages of 10-11 years may only dive to a maximum depth of 12 meters or 40 feet and must be accompanied by a PADI professional, or an Open Water Certified parent/guardian. Junior Open Water Divers between the ages of 12-14 years may dive to a depth of 18 meters or 60 feet, again accompanied by a PADI professional, or an Open Water Certified parent/guardian. A parent or guardian must accompany and diver under the age of 18.
- Weight: This tour has specific weight requirements.
- Age: This tour has specific age requirements.

NOTE: UNDER NCL POLICY, AN ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY ALL PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18.

### - GREAT STIRRUP CAY, BAHAMAS -

#### **PRIVATE ISLAND SNORKELING**

##### **Approximate Duration: All day**

One of our most popular programs, this snorkel experience is perfect for beginners and experts alike. You'll have your equipment all day, so you can snorkel when you feel like it. Ask any of the instructors on the beach for a free lesson, and then you'll be ready to explore the exciting underwater world of NCL's very own private island. Swim or wade around in the sandy shallows to check out the many schools of fish and our artificial reef. Or if conditions permit, swim outside the cove and discover deeper water and coral formations. You might even meet Bert & Ernie, our friendly resident stingrays. Your knowledgeable Dive In™ instructors will even snorkel around the cove with you to point out the local marine life during our complimentary guided tours, which depart from the beach hourly.

*Note: Participants must be able to swim.*

#### **GREAT STIRRUP CAY / WATER SPORTS**

Enjoy the beautiful waters of Great Stirrup Cay in any of these exciting ways:

#### **PARASAIL**

##### **Approximate Duration: Varies**

##### **Weight**

Sail 400 feet above the pristine waters of the Bahamas in tandem while being towed by a brand new parasail boat off the beach of Great Stirrup Cay.

*Note: Participants must weigh at least 60 lbs., but this might vary depending on the weather conditions of the day. Parasailing is seasonal and usually available during the summer months only.*

#### **SOFT FOAM FLOAT (All day)**

#### **LARGE INFLATABLE RAFT (All day)**

Enjoy a tranquil afternoon floating lazily in Bertram's Cove. Peek through the clear water below your raft to see colorful fish swim by.

#### **PADDLE VIEW BOATS (Per half-hour)**

See the amazing underwater world of the Caribbean but stay perfectly dry in this catamaran-style paddleboat with a viewing panel.

#### **KAYAKS (one or two person – per hour)**

This is the perfect time to learn or brush up on your kayaking skills in warm water. Kayaks are stable and easy to use.

### **Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours**

In the unique wilderness of the Florida Everglades, you will discover a complex ecosystem of vital importance to South Florida. A knowledgeable guide will tell you all about this fascinating "River of Grass". Enjoy a thrilling airboat ride to view birds and other wildlife in their natural habitat. Learn about the Everglades' most notorious creature, the alligator, in an educational wildlife show.

*Note: This tour is only for guests with flights departing after 3:30 pm from Miami International Airport.*

## EVERGLADES TOUR TO FT. LAUDERDALE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

### **Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours**

## VIZCAYA MUSEUM & GARDENS TOUR TO MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

### **Approximate Duration: 3 hours**

Step back in time as this tour offers a glimpse of a vanished lifestyle in America with an approximately 45-minute guided tour of a magnificent European-inspired estate, Vizcaya Museum and Gardens. Afterwards, take some time to enjoy the magnificent gardens, gift shop and cafe. The winter home of International Harvester vice president James Deering, Vizcaya, a National Historic Landmark, includes a house filled with art and furnishings and is set in the midst of magnificent formal gardens situated in a beautiful setting overlooking Biscayne Bay. Built in 1916, three architects participated in the creation of this estate and over 1,000 craftsmen and artisans worked on the house for two years.

*Note: This tour is only for guests with flights departing after 3:00 pm from Miami International Airport.*

## VIZCAYA MUSEUM & GARDENS TOUR TO FT. LAUDERDALE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

### **Approximate Duration: 4 hours**

## **- PHILIPSBURG, ST. MAARTEN -**

## RHINO RIDER

### **Approximate Duration: 3 hours**

### **Level 2, Age, Weight**

Experience on-the-water excitement with two-man Rhino Riders – zippy little 10-foot inflatable motorboats that are yours to command for a couple of hours of fun in the sun. Following a guide, you'll maneuver safely through anchorages for hundreds of boats and alongside mega-yacht marinas before exiting the lagoon into Marigot – the French capital of the island. View historic Fort Louis, which overlooks the bay, before continuing along the picturesque coastline, and settling at Happy Bay – your final destination. Hike the trail, or snorkel the reef (we'll provide the gear)!

*Note: Participants must be at least 18 years of age to operate the Rhino alone and be able to swim. Children must be at least 10 years old to participate. Pregnant women may not participate. Not recommended for those with back problems. This is a strenuous activity and is not suitable for all people. Maximum weight allowed per boat is 400 lbs. Complimentary soft drink, juice or water will be served at the beach.*

## SEE & SEA TOUR

### **Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours**

### **Level 2**

This tour combines the best St. Maarten has to offer, both on land and beneath the ocean's surface. Depart Philipsburg, on the Dutch side of the island, and drive up the eastern side to the second largest town in St. Maarten – Grand Case, surrounded by an idyllic bay. Here you will board a semi-submarine to take an approximately 45-minute narrated tour of the coral reefs surrounding Creole Rock. The vessel does not submerge; you descend into the hull of the boat and sit in air-conditioned comfort five feet below the surface of the water, exploring the sea life in this cruising underwater observatory through clear glass windows. The highlight of this portion of the trip is when a diver is surrounded by schools of fish and dangerous green and spotted moray eels. Once back on shore, your tour continues to the French capital of Marigot, where you will have time to explore this attractive port city with its sidewalk cafes, open-air market and duty-free shops.

## DISCOVER ST. MAARTEN ISLAND TOUR

**Approximate Duration 2 1/2 hours**

**Physically Limited**

Welcome to two countries under one sky. Leaving the pier, you will be whisked away into the serenity of this beautiful island with heavy European influence. Drive through the capital of the Dutch side along the salt pond, with a panoramic view of Dutch harbor. Continue into the villages of the French Quarter and up to the spectacular view of Orient Beach and neighboring islands, and then to Grand Case, well known as the gourmet capital of the Caribbean. Continue through the typical Caribbean villages and before you know it, you will have arrived at the French Colonial capital of Marigot for a 50-minute stop, during which you will be able to browse and stroll amid the quaint boutiques and outdoor markets. Then, you will enter the Dutch side and head up to Cole Bay Hill offering a wonderful view of Simpson Bay Marina and nearby islands. On arrival back at Philipsburg you will have the choice of returning directly to your ship or heading downtown for shopping.

*Note: Physically challenged participants must be accompanied and should be able to manage three steps in and out of the bus. Wheelchair must be foldable. Streets are uneven; heavy traffic may be encountered in Marigot and Philipsburg.*

## DIVI LITTLE BAY BEACH EXPERIENCE

**Approximate Duration: 3 3/4 hours**

**Physically Limited, Meal**

Overlooking the beautiful clear-blue Caribbean waters on the charming Dutch side of St. Maarten, you will find the Divi Little Bay Beach Resort. A short three-mile transfer from the pier takes you to the Divi Resort, where you will have the opportunity to spend some time on one of St. Maarten's most beautiful beaches. The resort features three freshwater swimming pools, music, beach activities and various other activities. You may choose to go for a swim in the ocean or just soak up some sun on the beach. Also on property is historic Ft. Amsterdam, where you can enjoy breathtaking views of the surrounding islands. Enjoy a beach barbecue lunch buffet along with two complimentary drinks of choice. Beach chairs are provided at no extra charge. Changing facilities, freshwater showers and a shopping promenade are all accessible from the beach. There is also an extensive water sports department, where equipment can be rented at an additional charge.

## GOLDEN EAGLE CATAMARAN

**Approximate Duration: 3 3/4 hours**

**Level 2, Age, Weight**

Count the flying fish or watch for dolphins while lying in the nets or lazing in the shade of an 80-foot tall sail. The Golden Eagle will nuzzle her bow into a fabulous pink sandy beach, without a doubt one of the finest you will encounter in the Caribbean. Stop for a swim in a quiet cove, snorkel in crystal-clear waters or bob around on a funky noodle beach float. Explore coral formations teeming with fish, or just sit back and relax. The friendly crew will provide you with complimentary snorkeling equipment, beach floats and, if required, will coach you on your snorkeling. Once homeward bound, the crew sets the sails and you cruise/surf downwind, listening to great music while enjoying champagne, rum punch, sodas and light snacks.

*Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age and not weigh over 300 lbs. This tour is on the French side of the island, and some nudity may be observed. Depending on sea conditions an alternative site may be substituted.*

## BOTTOM FISHING ADVENTURE

**Approximate Duration: 3 3/4 hours**

**Age**

After a five minute drive, we arrive at Doc Maarten Marina, where you will board and be welcomed by our crew of four. As you set sail for an approximately 45-minute cruise along the stunning St. Maarten coastline, you will be given your high-tech rod and reel and receive instructions from the crew. Upon reaching the fishing site we will drop anchor or drift, depending on the current, for approximately two hours of enjoyable bottom fishing. The mates will assist you in preparing and baiting your hooks. Your host/hostess will also be close by to serve you complimentary beverages throughout the trip.

*Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and if prone to seasickness take the necessary precautions. This is not trolling or big game/deep-sea sport fishing. This is a catch and release bottom fishing excursion. There is no guarantee of a catch. This is a hands-on tour, with no storage for bags on board.*

## BEACH RENDEZVOUS AT ORIENT BEACH

**Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours**

**Meal**

A short drive from Dutch St. Maarten brings you to one of the trendiest beachfront restaurants at Orient Beach, in French St. Martin. Critically acclaimed as being the French Riviera of the Caribbean, the beach offers more than one-and-a-half miles of white-sand fringed by coconut palms and seagrape trees. This location will provide you with everything you could possibly need for a great day at the beach. A welcome rum punch or soft drink is served upon arrival and a delicious lunch, including a beer, wine, soda or mixed drinks, is served at tables on the beach. Lounge chairs are available for rent.

*Note: Orient Beach is a European-style, clothing-optional beach. Complimentary drinks are maximum two per person. If intending to use water sports, a credit card is usually taken as insurance against damage.*

## **INDEPENDENT CAR EXPLORATION**

**Approximate Duration: 6 hours**

**Physically Limited, Age**

This tour offers a chance for the adventuresome to get away from the crowds, get behind the wheel and enjoy the lush countryside on a self guided tour.

*Note: Participants must be at least 25 years of age and provide a valid driver's license. Price includes full tank of gas, liability and CDW insurance. Be advised of heavy traffic in Philipsburg and Marigot during high season. Allow ample time for the return to your ship. A collapsible wheelchair can be stored in the luggage compartment of the car. Not all venues in the city are wheelchair accessible.*

## **BUTTERFLY FARM & MARIGOT**

**Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours**

**Physically Limited, Age**

After leaving Philipsburg (the Dutch capital), you'll head toward Le Galion beach, where the Butterfly Farm is located. As you are guided through this tranquil environment, some of the most spectacular and colorful butterflies from all over the world will be flying around. Your tour continues to Marigot, the stylish and cosmopolitan capital of the French side, where you'll have time to explore this attractive port city.

*Notes: Participants must be at least 4 years of age.*

## **MARIGOT YACHTING & SHOPPING**

**Approximate Duration: 5 hours**

Transfer from your cruise ship pier by bus for a narrated ride through the Dutch capital of Philipsburg to the famous Simpson Bay Lagoon, the largest natural lagoon in the world. After the class, you will have the chance to practice and gain some confidence in shallow water. A fun dive will start 20 feet below surface with your instructor.

*Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and in very good health. A waiver and a medical questionnaire must be completed prior to the dive. You must be able to swim. No prior Scuba certification is necessary. Tour includes all equipment. This is not a certification program. Approximate in-water time is 45 minutes.*

### SCUBA

**Approximate Duration: 4 hours**

**Level 2, C-Card, Age**

Come explore the largest shallow water coral reef in the Caribbean, and enjoy relaxing diving with outstanding visibility and little to no surge or current. During this two-tank dive tour, you will enjoy guided dives in depths of 35 to 65-feet, led by fully certified PADI Dive Masters and Instructors. Following an informative pre-dive briefing about each dive site and the local marine life, your first dive will take you to one of our local wrecks. Among our favorites are Buck Island Wildlife Refuge and the Wreck of the Cartanser Senor. The protected west cove offers year round sheltered diving, perfect for students and novices. Local weather conditions on the day of the dive determine the best dive sites.

*Note: All participants will have to fill out a waiver and fulfill all medical requirements. Wet suit rental is \$10. Not recommended for pregnant women.*

## - TORTOLA, BVI (VIRGIN GORDA) -

### **BEST OF TORTOLA**

**Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours**

**Physically Limited, Meal, Age**

*Note: A complimentary fruit punch and cold water will be served. Bring a towel, sunscreen, and a bathing suit.*

### **CATAMARAN CRUISE**

**Approximate Duration: 4 hours**

**Level 2**

Take a leisurely cruise along the south coast of the British Virgin Islands, where you will enjoy a few hours of breathtaking scenery. Cutting through the crystal waters of the Caribbean Sea, you will see other Virgin Islands, such as Peter, Salt and Cooper before it's time for your snorkeling experience. You will see dramatic coral formations, brightly colored tropical fish and, on occasion, a sea turtle or graceful ray. Few places in the world can compare to the underwater beauty of the BVIs. Your excursion then continues to a beautiful beach for swimming. On your return sail, relax on the deck as you enjoy a complimentary fruit punch.

### **THE DOLPHIN ENCOUNTER**

**Approximate Duration: 1 1/2 hours**

**Level 2, Age**

Your adventure begins when your guide greets you on the dock and explains the plan for your adventure. After check-in and a brief orientation, taxis will pick you up for a short transfer to the Prospect Reef facility. Then it's time for the encounter! You will descend a set of stairs into the beautiful Caribbean Sea on a submerged platform in waist-deep water, and have the opportunity to interact with the dolphins, including the swim-by and a kiss for a wonderful photo opportunity. The fast-swim allows the dolphins to demonstrate their incredible speed and power, and you will see several other behaviors designed to educate and fascinate you as you share an approximately 30-minute visit with these beautiful marine mammals. After the encounter, you will be able to view the photos and video taken during the program.

*Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age and be accompanied by an adult. Not recommended for pregnant women.*

### **DOLPHIN SWIM**

**Approximate Duration: 2 hours**

**Level 2, Age**

Participate in a memorable experience at the Dolphin Swim Program in a natural lagoon. You will travel through Road Town on a tour bus, heading from the cruise pier to the Dolphin Lagoon at Prospect Reef Resort. You will be asked to sign in before proceeding to the briefing room, where an approximately 30-minute introductory talk about the dolphins and procedures will be given. You will then have an opportunity to change into swimwear before joining the dolphin trainers poolside, where you will also be fitted for life vests. Then, enter the water and interact with the dolphins as they go through their 20- to 30-minute swim session. Typically, you will experience four to six behaviors while in the water.

### **Approximate Duration: 4 hours**

**Physically Limited, Age**

This tour affords a scenic drive that is designed for those interested in seeing most of the island while seated. After a brief walk from the gangway of your ship to the end of the cruise pier, you will board an open-sided bus, where the driver/guide will welcome you to the island. *Note: Participants must be at least 15 years of age and be comfortable walking approximately one mile. Alternate sites may be chosen due to unfavorable weather/sea conditions. All equipment is provided.*
