We are pleased that you are sailing with Norwegian Cruise Line. Join us as we sail to explore ports rich in history and culture, and venture beyond to some exotic, less traveled destinations. This document describes some of the optional excursions available in each port of call. To help you plan ahead, we've included detailed information about tours organized on your behalf. NCL's organized Shore Excursion program offers you the opportunity to sample the colorful culture and see the most dramatic scenery in each port of call. Pre-arranged sightseeing saves valuable time in port and helps ensure you receive the best services available.

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Why should I book an organized Shore Excursion?

There are a number of advantages to booking a Shore Excursion organized by Norwegian Cruise Line, including:

Satisfaction

We carefully monitor Shore Excursion programs to ensure we are offering the best tours available and meeting the diverse needs and interests of our guests. We use only reputable and licensed independent tour operators.

Convenience

Our organized tours maximize your time ashore and eliminate the need for time-consuming, last minute arrangements in port.

Service

We have a professional and knowledgeable Shore Excursion staff onboard, available to help you expertly plan your time ashore.

Safety

We have developed Shore Excursion programs with primary consideration for your safety and security.

Value

We review our tours continuously to ensure they are of the highest quality and that prices remain competitive.

How does the Shore Excursion program work?

Shore Excursions may be reserved in advance. A request form is provided at the end of this document so that you may finalize your plans well in advance of your cruise. This form must be received by NCL no later than two weeks prior to your sailing date. Do not send payment! Orders will be processed and billed to your onboard account. Shore Excursions are also available for purchase on board. Early in the cruise, the Shore Excursion Manager will present the most up-to-date information on ports and tours. Pick up a Shore Excursion order form at the Shore Excursion Desk. Return the completed form to the Shore Excursion Desk or Drop Box as soon as possible since all requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Purchases will be billed to your onboard account. Tickets will be delivered to your stateroom.

Are there any restrictions?

An adult must accompany participants under the age of 18 on all tours. There is no charge for children under the age of two who do not occupy a separate seat. Some tours have additional restrictions implemented for your safety. These may include age, weight, height and/or medical history related restrictions. Please refer to the individual tour description for any restrictions or consult with the Shore Excursion staff on board.

Should I tip the guide/driver?

Tipping is strictly optional; however, most tour guides and drivers expect and appreciate a modest gratuity. A commonly accepted guideline is \$1 per person for a half-day tour and \$2 per person for a full-day tour. If food and/or beverages are not included as a part of your tour, an additional gratuity for these services is appropriate.

What type of clothing should I wear?

We suggest you wear comfortable walking shoes or sneakers and dress in warm, layered clothing. Due to unpredictable weather, it is also advisable to bring along a sweater, windbreaker and/or rain gear, and bring sun protection for tours involving outdoor activities. All tours operate rain or shine! Do not forget your camera and plenty of film!

What tours are recommended for families?

All tours are suitable for families; however, we do not recommend flight seeing tours for children four years of age and younger. For a more affordable family experience, many tours offer lower prices for children. Some tours have additional age restrictions implemented for your safety. Please refer to the individual tour description for any additional restrictions or consult with the Shore Excursion staff on board.

Will we miss meals?

With Freestyle Cruising, you don't have to worry about missing a meal. Dining rooms offer open seating, and are open from 5:30p.m.-midnight every evening.

What if we miss the ship?

NCL does not leave port until all organized tours have returned to the ship. If you leave an organized tour however, or make tour arrangements on your own, please keep the time in mind and return to the ship at least 30 minutes before sailing.

Prior to your cruise, transfers may be purchased through NCL by calling reservations at 1.800.327.7030, or on board during your cruise at the Shore Excursion Desk.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Responsibility

NCL, as a convenience to its guests, may sell tickets for Shore Excursions or arrange other services which are operated by independent contractors not affiliated with NCL. NCL cannot be responsible for the acts or omissions of these independent contractors. NCL's responsibility to guests on board Norwegian Cruise Line vessels is governed by provisions in the Passenger Ticket Contract and does not extend beyond the vessel.

Cancellation or Modification

Cruise schedules are subject to change at the discretion of the Captain, and may occasionally be affected by variations in arrival or departure times, inclement weather, and mechanical or equipment difficulties. NCL reserves the right to change Shore Excursion prices and itineraries without notice. Excursions are subject to cancellation or modification depending on the number of guests participating. NCL reserves the right to cancel a Shore Excursion for any reason, including inclement weather, and shall not be liable for any loss to participants. Participants holding tickets for canceled Shore Excursions will receive a full refund. Should it be necessary to abandon a Shore Excursion due to difficulties en route, NCL will arrange the best possible refund for participants according to the circumstances.

Refunds and Cancellation Fees

All tours cancelled within 24 hours prior to arrival in the port where the tour is scheduled to operate are non-refundable.

Certain tours, such as overland tours, flightseeing tours, customized tours and tours with theater performances or special events may be subject to different cancellation fees. Check with the Shore Excursion Desk for details.

You can cancel a tour by returning the tour ticket to the Shore Excursion Desk and advising the staff of the cancellation. Refunds will be credited to the guest's onboard account.

Prices

Prices include meals and refreshments as indicated in the tour description (including gratuities for these services), plus guide and entrance fees, unless otherwise noted. There is no charge for children under the age of 2 who do not occupy a separate seat on a motorcoach tour. Children's prices are only available as indicated on the order form that accompanies this document. Participants under the age of 12 pay child prices and participants 12 years of age and older pay adult prices. All prices are in U.S. dollars.

Tour descriptions, Durations and Departure Times

The tour descriptions are as current and accurate as possible considering that this information is published several months prior to your cruise. Please note that occasionally changes in the description do occur. Any significant changes will be noted on the NCL website. Some tours will operate in an order that is different from that presented in the tour descriptions you originally read. This helps alleviate crowding at local venues. The information presented is designed to help you select the excursions most suited to your interests. The individual tour descriptions include approximate durations and can be found under each tour name. Please note that departure times are subject to change. Please check the NCL website (www.ncl.com/shorex) for the most current descriptions.

Insurance

The duties and liabilities of a particular tour operator and the scope and extent of the operator's insurance coverage may vary widely, depending upon the country's laws and customs. Because of this, many travel professionals advise their clients to strongly consider purchasing cancellation insurance and a short-term personal health and accident policy from a reputable insurance company before leaving home.

Personal Possessions

Personal articles including cameras, handbags, umbrellas, etc. are the guest's responsibility. NCL does not assume responsibility or liability for any item, or for personal effects, lost or damaged during any Shore Excursion or activity undertaken on behalf of the guest.

Tour Operators

Tour operators have the right to require any individual to withdraw from a tour at any time if they deem the individual's conduct detrimental to or incompatible with the interests, comfort, well-being or harmony of the group as a whole. Tour operators reserve the right to alter or adjust itineraries to meet local conditions for participant safety and convenience. Neither NCL nor local tour operators can extend financial reimbursement to compensate for a participant's disappointment in the event circumstances beyond the reasonable control of NCL or the tour operator make it impossible to provide services as intended.

Transportation

The best available local transportation is utilized in every port of call. However, guests should recognize that quality standards vary considerably throughout the world. NCL requests that all motor vehicles have air conditioning. However, this is not guaranteed. Cars, vans or taxis are often used in ports where coach transport is limited or not available.

Physically Challenged Guests

While NCL strives to make its Shore Excursion program available to all its guests, inherent tour venue limitations and/or tour operator limitations exist that are beyond NCL's control that limit the ability of guests with special needs to participate in certain Shore Excursions. We urge such guests to advise the Shore Excursion department of special needs when pre-booking tours and to further meet with the Shore Excursion Manager on board to discuss their special needs as they relate with the unique characteristics of each Shore Excursion. We typically recommend independent transportation for the comfort and convenience of guests with special needs. Wheelchair access may be limited – for details please consult your Shore Excursion staff before booking.

Tour Indicators/Symbols

- Level 1: Tours with this designation involve walking over relatively level terrain. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- Level 2: Tours with this designation can involve a considerable amount of physical activity such as climbing stairs or steep terrain and possibly the need for swimming in a light current, or bicycle riding. They are not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- Level 3: Tours with this designation involve physical exertion for extended periods of time. The terrain may be uneven or steep. They are recommended only for the physically fit and adventurous traveler.
- Physically Limited: Accommodates guests with limited mobility or in wheelchairs, provided there is a companion to assist them in and out of motor coaches or other transportation or with the navigation of venues with uneven terrain and/or steps insofar as some or all of the destinations on this tour do not provide special access and/or equipment. Wheelchairs must be collapsible.
- Meal: This tour includes a meal.
- C-Card: All participants must be certified Scuba divers and must have logged a refresher course within the past 12 months. You must present a nationally recognized Certification Card and fill out a short medical history and release form at the time of booking. If you are thinking of participating in the Scuba program and have a known medical condition, please get a clearance letter from your physician stating that you have no restrictions to dive. This should be done prior to taking your cruise and the original letter should be brought along with you. Junior Open Water divers between the ages of 10-11 years may only dive to a maximum depth of 12 meters or 40 feet and must be accompanied by a PADI professional, or an Open Water Certified parent/guardian. Junior Open Water divers between the ages of 12-14 years may dive to a depth of 18 meters or 60 feet, again accompanied by a PADI professional, or an Open Water Certified parent/guardian. A parent or guardian must accompany any diver under the age of 18.
- Weight: This tour has specific weight requirements.
- Age: This tour has specific age requirements.

NOTE: Under NCL policy all participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

SHORE EXCURSIONS

COZUMEL, MEXICO

Note: All mainland tours will require an approximately 45-minute ride (on 100-200 passenger ferries) between Cozumel Island and the mainland. The waters may be rough during certain seasons.

COZUMEL HIGHLIGHTS & SHOPPING

Approximate Duration: 4 1/4 hours

Your guide will give you an interesting narration of the largest inhabited island of Mexico and its background. Your first stop is the oldest settlement on the island, El Cedral. Learn about the ancient history of the Mayan culture that first inhabited this tiny village, the site of the first Catholic service in Mexico. Next, continue around the southern tip of the island to the east side, where you will see the untamed beaches on your way to El Mirador, a popular natural limestone formation. Your trip then takes you back into town for a stop at Cozumel's shopping district – don't forget your ship's recommended shopping guide. You can then decide whether to head back or stay in town and return to your ship later at your expense.

Note: Tour includes entrance fee to museum. Bring comfortable walking shoes. Sunscreen and bug spray are recommended. Trip also includes a 15-minute comfort stop.

TULUM MAYAN RUINS

Approximate Duration: 8 hours

Level 2, Meal

Come experience the world-famous, magnificent ruins of the walled city of Tulum, which rise high above the crystal-blue Caribbean Sea. As you enjoy a scenic drive to Tulum, your native guide offers a colorful narration and explains the history and culture of the Yucatan. (There will be an approximately 20-minute restroom stop en route to the ruins). When you arrive at the ruins, your guide will escort you through the walled Mayan city and share the secrets, facts, myths and legends of this long-forgotten society. Marvel at the 60 restored temples and the secrets that are hidden within these sacred walls. Visit the Temple of the Frescos, famous for its detailed carved figures, original paintings and centuries-old writings.

Note: There is a \$5-7 USD fee for the use of video cameras in Tulum. A boxed lunch will be provided. A complimentary drink is included. This tour may include a short shopping stop on your return to your ship.

CATAMARAN SAIL, BEACH PARTY & SNORKEL

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Set sail aboard a luxurious, custom-built 65-foot catamaran. Crew members will accompany you into the crystal-clear waters, where you can see for 100 feet. Discover stunning coral formations and a colorful array of marine life. After snorkeling, it's all-you-can-drink complimentary drinks, tropical margaritas, refreshing sodas and purified water as you sail to our private beach. While you're there, relax in a hammock in the shade of a Mexican palapa or sunbathe on a beach float.

DISCOVER COZUMEL & PLAYA MIA COMBO

Approximate Duration: 4 1/4 hours

You'll see the full spectrum of ocean blues and miles of virgin beaches on your way to "El Mirador." You will stop at this popular lookout, and its unusual limestone formations, for a photo opportunity. Then it's on to Playa Mia Beach Adventure Park to soak up some sun and a complimentary welcome drink at Cozumel's most popular beach. Take a dip in the pool or the crystal-clear Caribbean waters, or join in one of the many organized games and activities. For those who continue on, it's time to return to the heart of Cozumel's shopping center for a chance to see the city and practice the art of shopping.

Note: A complimentary drink at the beach club is included. Comfortable walking shoes, sun protection, swimsuits and towels are recommended. Legal drinking age in Mexico is 18 years of age.

PARASAILING IN PARADISE

Approximate Duration: 1 hour

Level 2, Age, Weight

Soar over Cozumel and take a birds-eye view of the beautiful beaches and turquoise waters found here in the Caribbean. See Cozumel as only the frigate and pelican can. Parasailing is fun, safe and easy. You and your partner will tandem fly over the azure waters of the Caribbean Sea. The departure takes place directly at the pier, so there is no transportation involved. At the end of your parasailing adventure you'll be returned directly to the pier.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and in good health. Maximum weight allowed is 350 lbs.

ATLANTIS SUBMARINE

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Age

Travel 100 feet below the sea and enjoy the magic onboard a submarine as you make the underwater journey to Chankanaab. An environmentally protected marine park, Chankanaab is home to a huge variety of sea life. Your adventure begins onboard a ferry vessel that takes you to the dive site. Marvel at the huge variety of tropical fish as your Captain expertly navigates through magnificent 30-foot coral heads and an experienced co-pilot provides an informative, live narration. After your dive, the submarine will resurface where the ferry vessel will be waiting to return you to your pick-up point.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age, three feet tall and be able to navigate a seven-foot ladder alone. Approximate dive time is 40 minutes.

TEQUILA TASTING PARTY

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Age

Tequila is actually the name of a valley in the State of Jalisco where this potent potable has been made for centuries. Much like a fine single-malt scotch, there are tequilas of surpassing quality that are to be similarly sipped and savored. And the flavors are every bit as subtle and complex. Delight yourself with a sampling of these very best tequilas, which include eight different types. Also, you will have plenty of Mexican snacks during the tasting. Within a few yards from the garden party happens to lie one of the loveliest beaches in the Caribbean. And you will have some time after the tasting to stroll along this beach and soak up its beauty.

Note: Participants must be at least 18 years of age. Bring walking shoes, bug spray, sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat.

DOLPHIN SWIM EXPERIENCE

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2

This is an incredible swim program where you will have the privilege to swim with a small group of people and two dolphins. You will view a brief dolphin presentation where you will be introduced to some of their extraordinary behavior. Then proceed into a vast enclosure of turquoise ocean water to swim and touch the dolphins in their own environment. You will enjoy several behaviors which may include a kiss, a foot push, a ride or flipper's shake. The dolphins are directed by the trainer to swim by each participant, allowing you to interact freely with the dolphins. The facility is ideally located right next to the island's best shopping.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 feet tall or 122 cm and in good health. Jewelry should be removed, as it is harmful to the dolphins. Pregnant women are not allowed.

DOLPHIN INTERACTION PROGRAM

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 1

This dream-fulfilling experience provides you with the opportunity to interact with bottlenose dolphins, in waist-deep water from a submerged platform. Before entering the ocean, you will be briefed by knowledgeable professional trainers about the dolphins' behavior, as well as the basic guidelines of the program. Then you will view a brief dolphin show, where you will be introduced to some of this extraordinary animal's behavior. This is a very hands-on program, allowing you, in a controlled setting, to get an up-close and personal lesson on dolphins as well as learning about dolphin behavior and adaptations they have made to the environment. You will even receive a kiss and pectoral fin shake!

Note: Participants must be at least 4 feet tall or 122 cm and in good health. Jewelry should be removed, as it is harmful to the dolphins. Pregnant women are not allowed.

SHOPPING & MEXICAN FOLKLORE SHOW

Approximate Duration: 2 1/2 hours

Physically Limited

Your guides will be waiting on the pier for you as you disembark your ship, and will transfer you to the meeting place downtown, where your shopping experience begins. Afterwards, experience Mexican culture in a colorful folkloric show which invites you to become acquainted with the Mexican culture. Once the show ends, you have the option of either continuing to shop, visiting downtown or returning to your ship.

DUNE BUGGY BEACH & SNORKEL COMBO

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age

Start your engines and hold on to your hats as you journey around the island in a customized Dune Buggy convertible! From the town of San Miguel, pass picture perfect natural terrain as your guide shows you the diverse regions and exotic beauty of Cozumel in this Buggy tour with a snorkel excursion, beach break and optional shopping experience! Drive your Buggy (4 guests per car) along the stunning paved coastal road to the white sands of a secluded beach where you'll find time to relax, play games and enjoy the Mexican snack buffet. Your tour includes an off-shore beginner's snorkel experience. Swim in the clear waters of the Caribbean and see the delightful array of sea-life Cozumel has to offer. When time's up you may return to your ship with the tour or be let off in the downtown shopping district. (Return fare not included. This option available as time allows and according to ship's departure time and location.)

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age to snorkel and must be at least 21 years of age and provide a valid license to drive. All cars are stick shift. Medical restrictions apply; visit the Shore Excursion Desk on board for details.

CLEAR KAYAK & BEACH SNORKEL COMBO

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 2, Age

The action begins as you paddle your two-person kayak out in the waters of the crystal clear Caribbean. Look down through your transparent kayak to see how blue that ocean really is and how bright those tropical fish are as they swim through the coral reef right beneath you. Once your unique journey through the reef is done, your beach break is only beginning. Return to the beautiful white sandy beach to relax in the shade, soak up the sun, or swim in the pool. You will also have the opportunity to revisit the reef to get an even closer look at the marine life in an optional snorkel.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age to snorkel and at least 6 years of age to kayak. Transportation back to your ship is at your own expense. Snorkel gear and a complimentary drink included.

PLAYA MIA DELUXE BEACH BREAK

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age

This tour has been designed to give you a worry-free day at Cozumel's finest beach club. Once you get to the beach club you'll enjoy the many services that are included in your package: beach chairs, umbrella, hammocks, the use of non-motorized water toys like kayaks, hobiecats, pedal boats, water trampolines and the incredible "Water Iceberg." Enjoy a delicious buffet served at the majestic Palapa restaurant.

Note: Motorized water toys are available at nominal fees. Minimum age for wave runner driving is 16 years of age. Legal drinking age in Mexico is 18 years of age. Playa Mia requires a valid photo ID as proof of age for alcohol consumption. Playa Mia reserves the right to refuse serving alcoholic beverages to intoxicated, unruly or underage guests. Full domestic open bar is included.

PLAYA MIA GRAND BEACH BREAK

Approximate Duration: Varies

See tour description above.

Note: Taxi transportation is at your own expense; a four-passenger, one-way ride is \$14 to \$15. Motorized water sports including wave runners, banana boat rides and parasailing are available at an additional cost.

DELUXE REEF SNORKELING & BEACH COMBO

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age, Weight

First you will take a boat ride to two of the most beautiful dive sites of Cozumel's National Marine Park: Paraíso and Dzul Ha Reefs. There you'll drift snorkel and discover the exotic reef fish, the magnificent coral formations and countless marine life. Then proceed to Playa Mia. You will enjoy a delicious buffet lunch and you'll have plenty of time to relax and enjoy the sun or have lots of fun with the many different activities which are included in your ticket: the Iceberg Water Mountain, kayaks, pedal boats, hobiecats, floating mats, inflatable tubs and much more.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age. The tour is a drift snorkel, so participants must know to swim. Water depth ranges from 10 to 40 feet. Maximum weight allowed is 250 lbs. Snorkel equipment and domestic open bar included.

XCARET

Approximate Duration: Varies

Level 2

Experience Xcaret, a beautiful and clean eco-archeological theme park that offers a naturally tropical exploration of the Caribbean jungle. Once you enter the park, you are on your own to explore and experience the beauty of nature. This theme park offers a museum, a bird sanctuary, stables, botanical gardens, restored Mayan ruins, a replicated Mayan village, beautiful beaches and natural pools. Enjoy a snorkeling experience through the mysterious underground river and swim with the friendly dolphins. The dolphin tour carries an extra charge and operates on a first-come, first-served basis (reservations are not available).

ECO JEEP® & SNORKEL ADVENTURE

Approximate Duration: 5 1/2 hours

Level 2

Leaving from the cruise ship pier on a Jeep Wrangler® (four wheel drive), you will head to Punta Sur. Visit the Punta Celarain Lighthouse and the Navigation Museum on ecological coaches and discover the Caracol Mayan Ruin. See the Colombia Lagoon, which feeds and provides balance to the reef formations. Then it's off to the beach to enjoy the crystal-clear waters. Here lies one of the few shallow reefs in the world, just three feet deep. Due to the bay's protection, it is safe from sea currents, and its sandy and shallow waters make it an ideal place for snorkeling. You can enjoy beach games or water sports or simply relax under the shade of our beach umbrellas. After leaving the park, you will ride onto the off-road track for an exciting and safe adventure.

Note: Participants must be at least 21 years of age to drive the vehicle and must provide a valid driver's license. Not recommended for pregnant women, people with back/neck injuries or those who have had recent surgeries.

MAYAN FRONTIER HORSEBACK RIDING

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age, Weight

Saddle up and travel back through time to the sacred lands of the Mayans, one of the oldest and most mysterious civilizations in the world. The exploration begins as you board the motorcoach, and takes a scenic island drive to the ranch, which is located in the heart of the island. Once there your cowboy guide will give you instructions on how to ride a horse and what you will be doing and seeing on the tour. Then your cowboy guide will escort you into the depths of the low island savannah, where the Mayans used to worship their gods. Ride around ruins that are more than 1,500 years old, view replicas of Mayan villages and discover remains of Mayan murals and idols.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and no more than 64 years of age, and not weigh more than 240 lbs. No pregnant women allowed. This tour is not wheelchair accessible.

CHANKANAAB PARK SEA TREK® HELMET DIVING

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Age

Sea Trek® helmet diving is the easiest and most comfortable way to explore the underwater. It is as simple as walking and breathing. You will be met at the gangway of your ship by the tour guides and escorted to taxis for an approximately five-minute ride to Chankanaab National Park. A space-age helmet will sit comfortably on your shoulders while a continuous flow of air provides breathing with ease. A Sea Trek® guide and two safety divers in Scuba gear remain with the group. The Sea Trek® staff entertains and stays close to you every step of the way. If you cannot swim, no problem! Sea Trek® was developed to allow non-swimmers to explore underwater. After the tour, you may enjoy unlimited use of Chankanaab Park, as well as complimentary snorkeling equipment. Guests who choose to stay longer are responsible for their return to the ship by taxi.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Maximum depth is approximately 20 feet. The underwater helmet-walking portion is approximately 25 minutes.

ALL-TERRAIN TRUCK & SNORKEL ECO-ADVENTURE

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age

The journey begins at the pier, where you will board our special All Terrain Truck along with your tour guide, who will prepare you for the expedition. Start the experience by crossing between a fresh water lagoon and the ocean where, Mother Nature allowing, you may see locals such as crocodiles and various types of tropical birds. You will be taken to a Mayan ruin and we will share with you its magical history and cultural traditions. Continue your experience by crossing through mangroves and low tropical jungle until arrival at the next attraction, the Punta Sur Lighthouse. The next stop is a secluded beach, where you will snorkel in the crystal-clear waters.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. This tour is not recommended for guests with heart or respiratory conditions or back/neck injuries, due to the rough terrain. Women who are pregnant cannot participate. This is an active excursion, and there is some walking involved. Tour includes all snorkel equipment.

JEEP EXPLORATION & SNORKEL

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age

Explore some of Cozumel's most diverse and beautiful areas as you travel around the island in this fun-filled Jeep tour (four guests per Jeep). Drive through the local neighborhood of San Miguel and past the extravagant hotel district, to the undeveloped eastern side of the island. Make a stop on the white sands of a secluded beach for a little fun in the sun and a Mexican snack. Then get ready for an off-shore beginner's snorkel experience, where you can see the colorful tropical fish and delightful array of sea life that Cozumel has to offer.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and at least 21 years of age and able to provide a valid license to drive. All cars are stick shift. Medical restrictions apply; visit the Shore Excursion desk for details.

ATV BEACH & JUNGLE ADVENTURE

Climb back on the ATV and head to the ruins of La Palma for an exciting glimpse of the long-lost Mayan Civilization.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age and maximum weight per ATV must not exceed 350 lbs. Drivers must be at least 16 years of age and bring a valid driver's license. Due to the rough terrain, this tour is not recommended for guests with heart, respiratory, back or neck conditions/injuries. Pregnant women cannot participate. We recommend you bring a bathing suit, towel, comfortable shoes, a hat and sunglasses. The snorkeling part of this tour will be replaced if bad weather conditions occur.

GOLF EXCURSION

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

We are proud to introduce Cozumel's first world-class championship golf course. Cozumel Country Club is a Jack Nicklaus-designed, 18-hole championship golf course. The course totals 6,847 yards from the back tees and has a fully-stocked pro shop. The Club offers a package that includes transportation, shared golf cart, and green fees. An outdoor palapa-style snack bar will provide snacks and beverages both on the course and at the turn.

MAYAN RUIN JUNGLE ATV

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Level 2, Age, Weight

This is a unique ATV adventure that leads you through the Cozumel jungle to ancient Mayan holy grounds! Your guide will take you from the pier via bus or van to the jungle welcome station, where you will find your single-person 250cc All Terrain Vehicle (ATV) and gear (helmet, goggles and a complimentary souvenir bandana). The journey begins as your guide leads you through the winding, narrow jungle paths full of tropical vegetation and wildlife. Along the way, you will visit some partially excavated Mayan ruins.

Note: Participants must be at least 16 years of age, must present a valid driver's license, and if under 18 years of age, must be accompanied by an adult. Maximum combined weight of each ATV is 364 lbs. Complimentary soft drinks or water and a complimentary bandana are included. Sun protection and bug spray are recommended. Must wear closed-toe shoes.

HIDEAWAY POWER BOAT & BEACH ESCAPE

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age, Weight

Get onboard your shared two-person speedboat as you head through the waves of the island's north side. Receive your safety equipment and orientation on the boats, then head out through the blue sea. Drive your boat past sugar-white beaches, hidden lagoons and local wildlife to a secluded beach where a Mexican grilled buffet lunch is waiting. Bask in the sun, swim in the ocean or explore the beach.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age and 18 years of age to drive the boat, upon presentation of a valid driver's license. Two complimentary soft drinks or water are included along with a buffet. Round trip transportation via taxi or van is included. We recommend you bring sun protection, a swimsuit, towel, water shoes and bug spray. Maximum combined weight of each boat cannot exceed 650 lbs. THE DOLPHIN SWIM AT CHANKANAAB PARK

Following the briefing, swimmers will enter the water standing on a submerged platform for an introduction to their new dolphin friend. Lots of contact will occur at this portion of the program as you get to touch the dolphin and pose for a big dolphin kiss. Next your trainer will lead you into deeper water where, wearing a lifejacket, you will perform various close-contact behaviors with the dolphin such as holding on to their pectoral fins as they pull you around or dancing belly to belly with your new friend. During the final part of your experience, you will be asked to don your mask and snorkel to accompany your dolphin and trainer. You will then have the opportunity to enjoy Chankanaab Natural Park and explore the botanical gardens.

Note: A complimentary Sea Lion show will be included as part of the tour.

DOLPHIN ENCOUNTER

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 1, Age

Interact with a dolphin at famous Chankanaab National Park. After an educational orientation, you will enter the water via stairs to arrive on a submerged platform and discover up-close the beauty and grace of these amazing mammals. You'll have approximately a half-hour to stand in waist-deep water and interact with these friendly marine mammals. After the encounter, there will be time to enjoy your day at the beach and shoreline reef or stroll along the botanical trail featuring Mayan cultural exhibits.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age. Jewelry should be removed, as it is harmful to the dolphins. Actual encounter time is 20-25 minutes. Transportation back to your ship is available every hour on the hour. A complimentary Sea Lion show will be included as part of the tour.

The walking tour concludes at the famous Chankanaab Lagoon, where the second phase of your journey starts. Our Cozumel buccaneers will test your pirate skills as you and your teammates will help to unravel a series of clues, located in the surrounding gardens, and spell out an ancient Mayan word. You'll enter the future in the next quest, when you receive your ultra-high-tech radio snorkel. Your narrative is actually transmitted through the mouth piece of your snorkel, where you receive crystal clear reception and live information about all that you are seeing. Fish ID cards are provided for easy fish location and identification. In this underwater park you can spot sunken ships, coral heads, statues and tons of colorful tropical fish. TABYANA BEACH PARTY & CANOPY TOUR

Approximate Duration: Varies

Level 3, Meal, Age, Weight

Come to Tabyana and experience a breathtaking rush as you defy the laws of gravity by sliding down cable to cable from the ridge of the mountain into a beautiful tropical park. Your journey starts at Creation Rock, where your guides outfit you with the finest canopy equipment (harness, safety harness, pulley and gloves). At the top, our guides brief everyone and begin the tour. The rush begins as you attach yourself to the cable, not knowing what it will feel like to be amongst the birds but knowing that you are safe and secure. The canopy tour consists of 11 stretches of cable and 13 stations, each cable measuring from 120 to 600 feet in length. Each station is located in the trees, between 18 and 30 feet off the ground. After your breathtaking experience, enjoy all the amenities that the Tabyana Beach package offers.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, in very good health and not exceed 225 lbs. in weight. Waiver forms must be signed for insurance purposes.

DISCOVER ROATAN ISLAND

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Come and explore the undeveloped east end of Roatan from the comfort of an air-conditioned bus or minivan. Experience the unique opportunity to enjoy the landscape and the local culture while your guide briefs you on the history of Roatan and the Bay Islands. Board an island-style boat for this pleasant, narrated trip through the historic two-mile-long Dixon Cove Harbor with its keys, reefs and visible shipwrecks. There are many photographic points on the journey. At Marble Hills Farm, sample delicious jellies and jams made from hibiscus, island plum, apples, bananas and other locally grown flowers and fruits. At YUBU the Garifuna Experience, you'll meet members of the Garifuna, descendants of Carib Indians who settled here in 1797. They will demonstrate their music and dance, which have been preserved over hundreds of years.

GUMBALIMBA PARK WITH LUNCH

You will be escorted from the pier to a waiting air-conditioned shuttle, then driven off on a 15-minute scenic drive to Fantasy Island. Here you are escorted to the private beach – a white sandy slip one mile long, covered with coconut and pine trees, awash in the sounds of tropical Caribbean music. You can enjoy a range of complimentary activities such as kayaks, tennis courts, ping-pong, billiards, darts, beach volleyball and bicycles, or just relax in a lounge chair.

HIKERS RIDGE & FOREST ADVENTURE

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 3, Age, Weight

Discover the beauty of the Island of Roatan as you approach the harbor, then enjoy the wonderful experience of introducing yourself in to the lush green forest. Then, climb through the majestic white and black Oak Walks on the way to Mount Mariah, one of the highest points on the island. You will enjoy the many views of different scenes of the surrounding towns of Coxen Hole, Spanish Tow, Gravel Bay and Flowers Bay. The hike continues down hill, where you will have opportunities to view your ship and harbor. Next stop is Bella Vista Restaurant, where you will be offered various fruit juices.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, in good health and not to exceed 250 lbs.

HIKE & BEACH TOUR

Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours

Level 2, Meal

Take a hike on the wild side and watch the playful monkey lala lizards scurry along the jungle trails as you enjoy flowering plants, orchids, exotic spices and fruit trees (including the wildly popular chocolate tree and, of course, the world-famous mahogany tree). Be sure to bring your camera as you make your way to the summit of Carambola Mountain. Upon reaching the top, sit and relax on the summit deck and enjoy Roatan's most magnificent views, with all the colors of the distant coral reef laid out before you. The gardens offer a perfect place for hiking, bird-watching, wildlife, scenic photography, nature studies and relaxation. An interesting new area is reserved for the island's medicinal plants. Just a short distance from the gardens is Las Palmas Oceanside Village, where you will be served a picnic lunch. This charming village offers a cozy beach cove for swimming, thatched covered decks and colorful artisan pavilions for shopping.

ROATAN DIVE INT™

CORAL CAY SNORKEL EXPERIENCE

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Upon your arrival, your guides will transfer you to a natural and relaxing location. Experience a pristine tropical island setting, where white sand beaches and crystalline waters beckon. Experience a place where the entire family can enjoy all types of water sports. Experience a place where you can watch the majestic rays, encounter the wonderful world of sea turtles, visit lobster and echinoderms pools and learn of many other marine species that inhabit our waters. Don your snorkel equipment or just relax in the Honduran sun.

TABYANA BEACH PARTY & SNORKEL

Approximate Duration: Varies

Level 2, Meal

Spend your day at this beautiful and simple private beach resort located on Roatan's famous West End. You'll be given snorkel equipment from your ship to use at your leisure. The Great Mayan Reef is a very popular snorkel, with easy walk-in entry and access to many different species of fish, coral, stingrays and turtles. It is also at a comfortable depth of approximately 15-20 feet, ideal for beginners and experts alike. Instructors from the ship will be on hand at the beach to offer you an optional site orientation and provide regularly scheduled guided reef tours. After snorkeling, enjoy an outdoor American-style lunch (hamburgers, hot dogs, etc.) and have a drink at the cash bar. You can even pick up a few souvenirs at the gift shop.

Note: Travel time is approximately 35 minutes each way over a scenic, unpaved road. Lifeguards patrol in kayaks at beach location.

DISCOVER SCUBA

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Level 2, Age

This is an introduction to the sport of Scuba diving. Following a short video or classroom session, you will practice your skills in shallow waters and then move on to the dive at no more than 40 feet of depth.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age. Certain medical requirements must be met in order to participate in this tour. No prior Scuba experience is necessary. You must be able to swim. Tour includes all equipment. Actual guided Scuba dive is approximately 20 minutes. This is not a certification program. Maximum depth is 40 feet; average depth is 15-20 feet. The operator may offer a second dive for \$30 cash, payable at the site.

REEF SHARK DIVING EXPERIENCE

Approximate Duration: 3 3/4 hours

Level 2, C-Card

The dive spot is a 2.5-mile (15 min.) ride from our Roatan shop. Once the group arrives at the spot on the Bay Island reefs, they descend to a depth of about 70 feet and form a semicircle on the sandy bottom along a wall of large coral heads. Some time (about 15 minutes) is then allotted to let all the local wildlife become accustomed to your arrival and return to normalcy as you relax and watch a school of about a dozen sharks circling before you. The dive master will then pull the rope that releases the lid to the five-gallon bucket of small fish (shark food) that was brought down with the group, but resides a safe 20 feet away. The sharks will quickly consume the contents of the bucket. Then, other fish will venture into the area to clean up any morsels that might have been missed. The total time in the water will be about 45 minutes. The experience of seeing this intense and dramatic phenomenon in person from only 20 feet away will live vividly in your memory for the rest of your life.

WALL & REEF CERTIFIED DIVE

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, C-Card

The term 'world-class diving' is no exaggeration when it comes to Roatan. The waters around the island are filled with a wide assortment of colorful marine life. The coral reefs are known for their spectacular drop-offs, where the reef plunges vertically into the depths of the sea. A professional local dive operator will take you on a two-tank Scuba adventure to these beautiful reefs.

Note: All divers are required to demonstrate clearing a fully flooded mask before participation. Certain medical requirements must be met in order to participate in this tour. Equipment provided: tanks and weights. All other equipment may be rented from the dive operator at a nominal charge.

BELIZE CITY, BELIZE

AIRBOAT ADVENTURE & BELIZE CITY TOUR

Approximate Duration: 2 1/2 hours

Level 1, Age

Your tour guide will acquaint you with the rich history of the city, from its establishment by shipwrecked British sailors in 1683 to today. Pass St. John's Cathedral (the oldest in Central America), the current Prime Minister's residence and many more interesting sites. After your 40-minute city tour, you will be taken to an airboat outpost situated on a waterway just past milepost nine on the Western Highway. As your Captain opens the throttle, you feel the breeze tugging at your skin while your boat rips across the Almond Hill Lagoon at speeds over 40 miles-an-hour towards the manatee feeding grounds. See beautiful water lilies, many colors and varieties of wading birds, turtles and maybe even crocodiles.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age.

LOST WORLD CANOPY TOUR & RAPPELLING

Approximate Duration: 5 1/2 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age, Weight

This journey takes you through Belize's sparsely populated countryside and then into the untouched Belizean jungle. You will enter into a cavernous tunnel which leads to a primeval rainforest encircled by crevassed rock walls more than 100 feet tall, inside of which dwell many creatures of the night, including vampire bats. This is where your tour of the Lost World Cave begins. There are five traverses, ranging from 105-500 feet apart, that take you across the fallen ceiling of this enormous open-air cave. You will be met by our well-trained staff for your orientation and safety briefing before being suited up. Your journey starts with traversing from platform to platform above the floor of the densely populated forest, reaching for sunlight above the rim of the cave. Each platform is perched on the inside face of this open-air crater, giving you an unforgettable experience. Your last traverse takes you to a rock shelf protruding from the side of the large tunnel-like entrance to the cave, where your tour ends with an exciting rappel to the floor.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs. Lunch is included. Wear comfortable clothing that you do not mind getting a little dirty – jeans or shorts with sneakers. Closed-toe shoes are recommended, although strap-on sandals are acceptable. We recommend you bring insect repellent, sunscreen and a small backpack or fanny pack. Anything you take must be carried by you throughout the entire tour. Not recommended for pregnant women.

CAVE TUBING & JUNGLE TREK

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age

A tender transfer to Belize City and a journey 37 miles up the Western Highway brings you to the Caves Branch River and its winding path through the Maya Mountains, including numerous ancient caves once inhabited by the Maya. Upon arriving at Jaguar Paw, your headquarters for the day, be prepared for an approximately 45-minute hike down a jungle trail. Your guide hands out headlamps, and you are ready to float in inflated inner tubes, taking you through the cave system. Intricate crystalline formations line the cave, and the majestic rise and fall of stalagmites and stalactites add to the serene opulence of nature. On several occasions, you will emerge into the sunlight, only to enter into another cave system. This part of the adventure lasts about two hours.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and able to swim, as this is an active water sport tour. The cave system and its waterways may cause claustrophobia and panic in a very small percentage of guests. For the approximately 45-minute walk through the jungle, wear suitable footwear for muddy, wet trails. It is recommended that you wear your swimsuit and bring a change of dry clothes and insect repellent. Lunch will be provided.

ALTUN HA MAYAN RUINS

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Level 2

Come and explore the most accessible Mayan ruins in Belize. Travel for approximately one hour from Belize City along quaint country roads to the ancient site of Altun Ha. This site captured world attention when Dr. David Pendergast discovered the now famous nine-and-a-half pound jade head of the sun god named Kinich Ahau in the tomb of the Royal Priest, within the main temple. Three plazas and 13 structures mark the epicenter of this important ceremonial site. Prepared stone steps allow you to climb to the top of three of the main temples.

Note: The drive to Altun Ha is approximately 50 minutes, with the last five miles to the site on bumpy and unpaved roads.

JUNGLE BUGGY & MAYAN CAVE EXPLORATION

Approximate Duration: 5 1/2 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age

Your onboard tour guide will provide a brief history of Belize, its people and culture along your drive. Upon arrival at Big Hill Station, there will be a short orientation and safety briefing. At a point on the Savannah, you will see why you have been put aboard these themed, customized machines called "Monster Jungle Buggys." This is a special-purpose half-tracked vehicle that provides passengers with a 10-foot high secure observation platform with a panoramic viewpoint that can access some of the most beautiful inner parts of Belize that remain unspoiled by virtue of the difficult access. As you round the final bend, you arrive at a small clearing in the dense forest. Hold your breath as your skilled driver maneuvers your buggy to the docking station in the middle of nowhere. Off-loading onto the platform, a wooden bridge then leads you into the jungle and up to the entrance of a Mayan cave. Enter into a cavernous tunnel which leads to a primeval rainforest encircled by crevassed rock walls more than 100 feet tall, in which dwell many creatures of the night, including vampire bats. Your guide, an indigenous Mayan Picadoro, will escort you along the "picado" footpath at the edge of this Jurassic-like forest, where a myriad of vines and bromeliads hang from the rock ledges and ancient trees.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age and in good health. Lunch is included. Bring comfortable clothing, insect repellent and sunscreen.

CATAMARAN & BARRIER REEF SNORKELING

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

Level 2

Depart directly from your ship aboard a high-speed, 65-foot catamaran. While underway, your friendly crew will provide professional instruction on the use of complimentary first-class snorkel equipment. Once the catamaran anchors in the lee of the sand atoll, the crew will accompany you into the crystal-clear waters. The beauty of this location is that it has areas for beginners and experts alike, both with extraordinary coral formations teeming with colorful tropical fish. After snorkeling, you can relax on a white sand beach under a coconut tree, explore the area on a kayak or float in the water on a comfortable beach float, all while being served complimentary rum punch, sodas and bottled water.

Note: Please bring sunscreen and a towel from your ship.

XUNANTUNICH: EL CASTILLO

Approximate Duration: 6 1/2 hours

Level 2, Meal

Once at the river and at the base of the site, you will board a hand-cranked ferry to journey across the river. The impressive architectural structure of the 130-foot El Castillo pyramid is visible for miles around. Those who venture to the top will also enjoy a panoramic view of the Belizean and Guatemalan countryside. The site has three plazas and a partially excavated ball court. After your visit to the site, you will return to your coach and travel to a quaint restaurant for a typical Belizean lunch.

Note: Comfortable clothing, walking shoes and a hat are recommended.

AERIAL TREK & CAVE TUBING

Approximate Duration: 7 1/2 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age, Weight

The ultimate adventure. Your first activity is the aerial trek, a zip line tour through the rainforest. The zip line tour features an intricate harness system of pulleys on horizontal traverse cables, which lets you swing 100 to 124 feet between platforms and 70 feet high in the trees at canopy level. The next two hours are spent flying through the forest with the birds. Your next adventure for the day is cave tubing. Be prepared for a 45-minute hike down a jungle trail to the tunnel that heads into the underground cave system – the start of an "eye-opening" adventure. Your guide hands out headlamps and you are ready to float in inflated inner tubes, with the gentle currents taking you through the cave system. Intricate crystalline formations line the cave, including the majestic rise and fall of stalagmites and stalactites.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, weigh no less than 95 lbs. and no more than 350 lbs. Please come dressed in a bathing suit, T-shirt, shorts and tennis shoes (which will get wet) or water shoes and bring a towel. A change of clothes and shoes is recommended, as well as insect repellent. The cave system and its waterways may cause claustrophobia and panic in a very small percentage of guests. Not recommended for pregnant women. Lunch and refreshments are provided after the Ariel Trek.

LAMANAI & THE NEW RIVER SAFARI

Approximate Duration: 7 1/2 hours

Level 2, Meal

An approximately 45-minute drive up the Northern Highway brings you to Tower Hill, where you board a riverboat and head up the New River. While traversing the many little creeks and lagoons, it is easy to encounter hawks, kites and falcons. Dainty Jacanas lightly walk on the lily pads while the crocodiles bask in the morning sunlight. At the entrance to the New River Lagoon, the ruins of Lamanai (Maya for "submerged crocodile") rise into view. While you tour this site, huge masks depicting dead rulers and gods seem to materialize out of the rainforest, amid the chatter of bird life and the haunting call of the howler monkeys.

Note: Lunch is provided.

BELIZEAN BEACH DAY

Approximate Duration: Varies

Come explore Belize's hidden treasures at Sargents Caye on the barrier reef. Swim alongside southern rays, nurse sharks and other tropical rarities in the morning or afternoon while enjoying the other half of your day on the beach at Coral Sands Beach Resort. Each tour provides ample time to go for a swim and lounge in a hammock. Enjoy a delicious beach BBQ lunch, available at an additional cost.

Note: Complimentary use of kayaks included.

JUNGLE POOLS & CAVE EXPLORATIONS

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal

Board a comfortable tour bus at the Tourism Village in Belize City for your 80-minute drive up the Western Highway. Check out the Latin American refugee villages of Santa Clara and Armenia just before your arrival at St. Herman's Cave, ancient worshipping ground of the Maya. Your guides will lead you with headlamps into this beautiful cave, with its burbling mineral spring creek, crystal formations and far-reaching stalagmites and stalactites. Then, move over to the Inland Blue Hole for a picnic lunch and a swim in the clear waters of this "cenote" of the Maya.

Note: Please bring a towel and bathing suit.

BEER & THE CITY

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Physically Limited, Age

Following your Belize City Tour, you will travel 10 miles up the Northern Highway to Ladyville Village, the production center of the world famous Belikin beer. Tour this great beer-making facility and then enjoy all the ice-cold beer you can drink, along with snacks. Then it's back to Belize City for duty free shopping before boarding the tender back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 18 years of age.

BELIZE ZOO & THE BELIZE RIVER

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal

Over a hundred species of wildlife, all indigenous to Belize, have found a perfect home at the Belize Zoo, established by a U.S. immigrant over 20 years ago, in the Belize District. Most of the creatures, in fact, were brought to the zoo, having been found damaged either by man or in some accident, and nursed back to good health. You will have the chance to see magnificent jaguars, jaguarondi, margay, puma, ocelot, otters, parrots, hawk-eagle, tapirs, white-lipped peccary, havelinas, and gibnuts. From crocodile to Jabirus storks, the zoo makes your visit worthwhile. Enjoy a delicious Belizean lunch followed by a picturesque boat tour along the historic Old Belize River.

Note: This tour is also conducted in reverse. Please bring a hat and sunscreen.

BELIZE DOLPHIN ENCOUNTER

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age

After being picked up at your ship and transferred to the Spanish Bay Conservation and Research Center, you will be given an educational orientation session on dolphin anatomy, behavior and training methods. You will then wade into waist-deep water from a sandy beach in groups of six to eight people and see these animals up close, with a trainer demonstrating training techniques and behaviors.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age and in good health. Actual time in the water with dolphins varies.

REEF BOTTOM FISHING

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Age

This excursion is fun for the whole family. For this type of fishing there are lots of snapper and grouper, not to mention barracuda and other reef fish waiting to give you a fight! Deck hands will be onboard to insure all you have to do is fish. They will bait your hooks, remove and mark your catches, un-snag your lines and even help you fight the big ones if you snare one. This is the easiest type of fishing available.

Notes: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Bring sunscreen and sea sick medication if needed. Smoking is prohibited on board the vessel.

MAYAN PALACES OF CAHAL PECH

Approximate Duration: 5 1/4 hours

Level 1

The day begins with a journey to the western town of San Ignacio, where the Maya site of Cahal Pech is located. Perched proudly on a hilltop, Cahal Pech boasts extensive restoration to its masks, facades, terraces, stairways and structures. Clusters of temples and palaces are arranged around a series of plazas on this six-acre site. After a detailed tour of this site, the journey continues on to Caesar's Place for a snack break and a visit to the gift shop.

MANGROVE TUNNELS & CITY MUSEUM

Approximate Duration: 3 1/2 hours

After your tender ride to the docks, you board your bus for a short ride to the Museum of Belize, which focuses on the Mayan and Colonial history of the country. Highlights include priceless Mayan artifacts dating back some 2,500 years. After approximately 1 1/2 hours at the museum, you then move on to the second portion of the tour, which focuses on natural history. Then board comfortable boats for a leisurely cruise up the Halouver Creek, where mangrove branches on either side intertwine high overhead to form a living tunnel. These tunnels are home to healthy populations of wildlife, so be on the lookout for various bird species, iguanas and crocodiles. The cruise ends at the Belize Tourism Village, where you catch the tender back to your ship.

ALTUN HA & THE OLD BELIZE RIVER

Approximate Duration: 6 1/2 hours

Meal

A tender transfer to Belize City and an enjoyable boat ride take you several miles inland by way of scenic Old Belize River. En route you may see iguanas, several varieties of birds, crocodiles and howler monkeys. At Burrell Boom, a quaint settlement on the riverbank, you will be served a tasty local lunch with refreshments at The Olde River Tavern, located on the banks of the Old Belize River. You will then board your tour bus and drive to Altun Ha (Mayan for "Rock Stone Water"), where Dr. David Pendergast of the Royal Ontario Museum uncovered the famous Jade Head Kinich Ahau.

THE CITY & THE SANCTUARY

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1

A tender transfer into Belize City will be the start of your tour of the Belize Zoo, created as a sanctuary for the country's indigenous species. The Belize Zoo was first created for animals that were injured or donated to the facility and could not be returned to the wild. The zoo is home to an impressive array of large cats, primates, reptiles and birds, and gives you the opportunity to view Belize's prolific wildlife in one location. Then it's on to see the city sights. Belize City today remains the commercial capital of the country and is home to about 75,000 people.

Note: Animals in the zoo are not in cages but protected by fences. The zoo is not recommended for wheelchairs, walkers or canes, as it has loose gravel paths.

AMPHIBIOUS RIVER TOUR

Approximate Duration: 5 1/4 hours

Depart Belize City by motorcoach to Peccary Park in the nearby village of Gracie Rock. Peccary Park is set in the rainforest and rolling hills of this quaint village once inhabited by the Maya and in later years by Colonial loggers. Here, you will enjoy a snack and have leisure time for a swim in the refreshing waters of the Sibun River. You then board "The Crock," a customized amphibious vehicle, for a leisurely tour of rainforest trails, caves once inhabited by the Maya, jungle rivers and swamps.

JUNGLE HORSEBACK & RIVER CRUISE

Approximate Duration: 7 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age

After being dropped ashore, you will be taken on an approximately one-hour drive to Banana Bank, where you will experience the excitement of the jungle. Located on the Belize River on 4,000 acres of land, half of which is primary growth rainforest, the site provides every opportunity to see and feel the true character of this beautiful country while on horseback. Back at the ranch, enjoy a traditional Belizean meal and some leisure time to view wildlife on the property, including a jaguar, a howler monkey and numerous exotic birds. There is also an art gallery with treasures by a world-famous artist. You will then be taken on a boat ride down the river, where the eye-catching scenery and miles of unspoiled nature are yours to explore. Visit beautiful Guanacaste Nature Park prior to returning to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. Changing facilities and restrooms are available at the ranch. Wear long pants and bring insect repellent. Duration of the horseback ride is approximately one hour and 20 minutes. Lunch is provided.

TALE OF TWO CITIES

Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours

This fascinating half-day tour will focus on the contrast between the ancient Maya city of Altun Ha and modern day Belize City, highlighting 1,000 years of development within this former British Colony. Altun Ha (Mayan for "Rock Stone Water") thrived as a trading post to the Maya World during the Classic and Post Classic periods. The site was made world famous by Dr. David Pendergast of the Royal Ontario Museum upon his discovery of the world's largest carved Jade Head, depicting the sun god Kinich Ahau.

Note: The Belize City tour portion is conducted on a bus without stops.

RAINFOREST ATV

Approximate Duration: 4 1/2 hours

Level 2

Approximately 45 minutes after departing Belize City, you arrive at the ATV base of operation. It is now time to explore the jungles of Belize on trails laid out over 100 years ago by loggers in search of precious mahogany trees. The trails are a good mix of various challenging terrains leading to your first stop of the day – the Maya Caves. Here, you will explore caves used by the Maya thousands of years ago. As you explore the cave, be on the lookout for ancient ceramic pots forgotten for centuries. After this stop, it is time to loop back to home base via jungle trails. After turning in your equipment, feel free to take a swim in the refreshing waters of the Sibun River. A snack of fresh fruit, nachos and fruit juice is served.

WILDLIFE ADVENTURE

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 1, Meal

After a brief tender ride to Belize City, you will board a motor launch for a guided tour of the nearby Olde Belize River. On this scenic waterway, look out for crocodiles, howler monkeys, iguanas and many birds. Turtles, manatees and dolphins are frequently spotted as well. Some 20 miles upstream, you will disembark at The Olde River Tavern for a tasty Belizean lunch and refreshments. From here you will then travel by road to Belize's famous wildlife habitat, the Belize Zoo. This facility is home to the endemic species of the region that are cared for in their natural environment behind protective fencing.

Note: Animals in the zoo are not in cages but protected by fences. The zoo is not recommended for wheelchairs, walkers or canes, as it has loose gravel paths. Boats will not be covered. Bring sun block and hat.

RIVER KAYAKING SAFARI

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age

A tender transfer to Belize City and a short drive up the Northern Highway will bring you to the village of Baker's Ranch on the Belize River. Your tour guide will brief you on kayak handling. The noiseless approach of the kayaks allows you to sneak up on sunbathing crocodiles, iguanas and turtles. The river foliage of bamboo forests and cohune royal palm trees are home to many species of birds.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, able to swim and be physically fit. You will kayak for about two to three hours, depending on the river's current and the agility of the group. Wear shoes that can get wet. A motorized chase boat accompanies the group at all times. We recommend you bring dry clothes to change into after the tour. In compliance with insurance requirements, liability waivers are required for this activity. Lunch and refreshments are provided.

THE THRILLER ADVENTURE

Approximate Duration: 6 1/2 hours

Level 2, Meal, Age

Following a 1 1/2-hour scenic drive, you arrive at the jungle, where your Mayan adventure awaits you. After a brief orientation, board an exciting safari ride and travel down a rainforest trail on your way to the roaring river. Lie back on your tube and let the gentle current take you down the river. Keep a look out for iguanas, exotic birds and other wildlife that love to bask in the towering fig trees above. Stop for a refreshing dip in one of the river's crystal-clear swimming holes, and emerge in the midst of an ancient Mayan tomb site, Hubelna, perched on a hill overlooking the river.

The speedboat ride just inside the barrier reef gives you a glimpse of other cays and mangrove estuaries.

The coral formation is typically a spur-and-groove formation, with the top of the reef being approximately 35-40 feet with a wall to more than 100 feet with a shelf and additional wall drop.
